ABOUT ARC

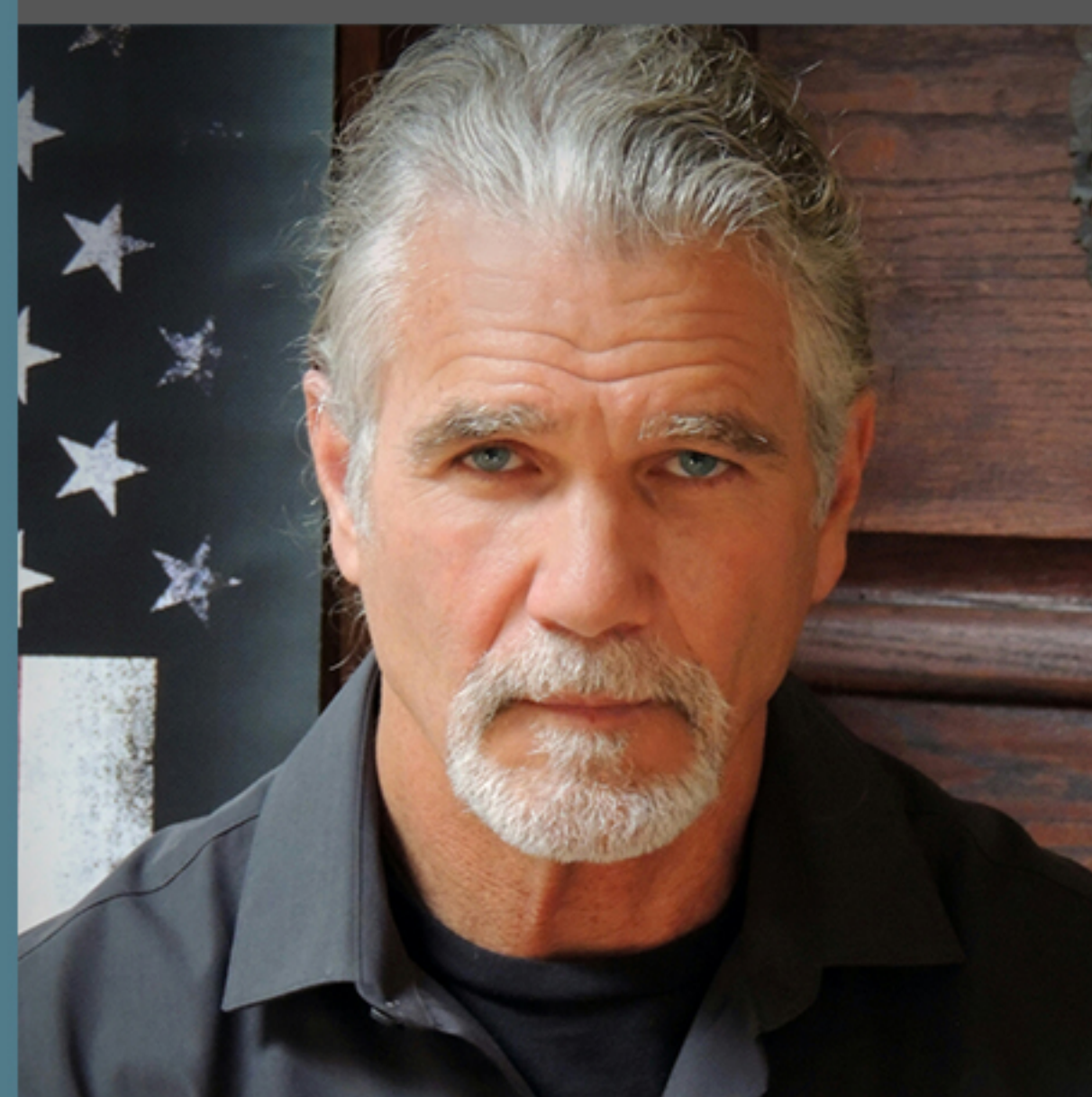
