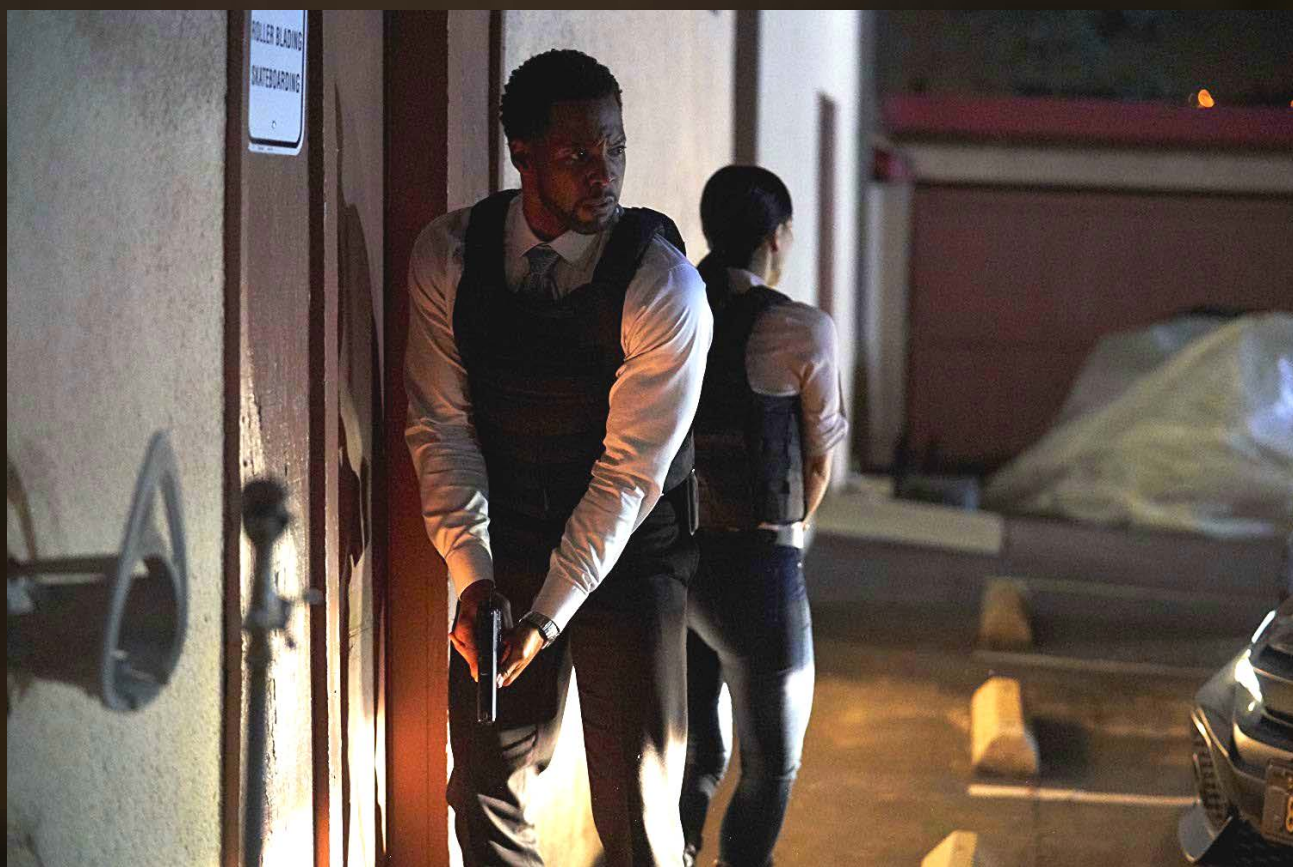


One girl's nightmare, a nationwide reality.

Lost Girls - a narrative feature about child trafficking in the US.

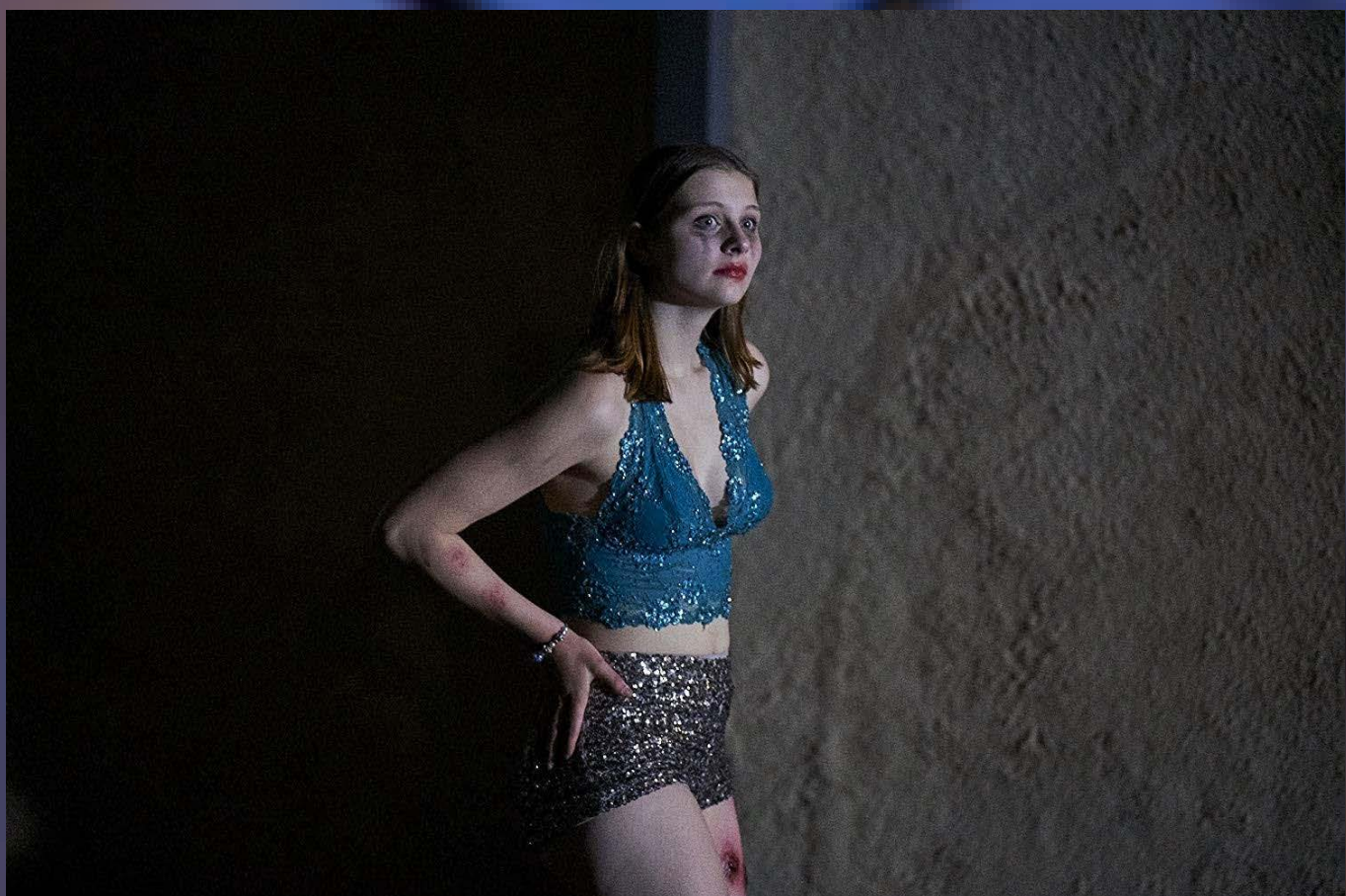
This emotional drama showcases the real problem parents in America face today, and the need to protect and educate their children about trafficking. Told through the eyes of teenager Angie Morgan, the story begins with her unbeknownst recruitment to sex traffickers by a teenage boy, 'Mario', who claims to have just moved to the area, and takes an interest in her and her music.



When Angie's parents fail to turn up for her school's music recital, she agrees to meet Mario's uncle who is said to be connected in the music business, and can help her make it big. Angie is led into the trap of traffickers who rape and abuse her and threaten that if she tries to leave, they will show her parents a video of her rape. Full of shame and fear, Angie resigns herself to her new life of entrapment.



As the story unfolds, we are taken through the families' journey of dealing with their loss and Angie's ways of enduring her situation. When Angie finally escapes her captors and is brought home, the family is sad to find a very different daughter from the one they knew, and Angie is confronted with many tough choices on her journey to recovery.
